It also aims to empower women in an industry that was historically male only. The Miss Sake Organisation supports and encourages the increasing number of women in Japan that are becoming Master Brewers and Brewery Presidents where once this was not the case.

Miss Sake Australia will have the chance to enjoy paid attendance to events and functions throughout the year as an official Cultural Ambassador.





The successful candidate will be an articulate, charismatic individual who has a genuine interest in sake, Japanese cuisine and the culture of Japan.

Applications are now being accepted between 10 December 2018 - 27 February 2019.
